SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing, adoption of the amendment to the permanent rules. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment as offered by the Rules Committee.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. We're back on the adoption of the permanent rules. Further discussion? Seeing no lights on, Senator Baker, did you wish to close on your motion?

SENATOR BAKER: Well, thank you, Senator Cudaback, members. I simply would repeat the motion to adopt permanent rules for the Ninety-Eighth session of the Legislature...or Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. The motion before the body is to adopt the permanent rules for the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session. You've heard the motion. The motion before the body is to adopt the permanent rules. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The motion before us is to adopt the permanent rules for the second session. A record vote has been requested. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
