SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Thank you, Senator Cunningham. Senator Schimek, earlier you had talked about some type of a compromise. You asked Senator Foley if he'd be willing to do some type of a compromise. And I must tell you that, as I said earlier this morning, that, you know, I'm kind of indifferent towards this bill, but if you think about our agenda and the things that we have to do this year, it's quite a full slate. And so I just kind of wanted to explore that a little bit further, if you are willing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Sure.

SENATOR BOURNE: What did you...what did you envision or what are you suggesting as an alternative to a written-type notice that's already contemplated in law?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. I'd be happy to answer that. Actually, it's a bill that was introduced three times in this Legislature and that Senator Bohlke eventually got to Select File and it ran out of time. It wasn't prioritized. But what it does is that it requires...first of all, it replaces the requirement in the bill that they have to provide the single sheet of paper that tells what the law is. It says that school districts would be required to post and leave posted a toll-free number that will provide that information. The number shall be posted throughout the year in a prominent location available to all students in grades 7 through 12.

SENATOR BOURNE: So what type of notice? You're saying it's a notice that would be posted in the school building itself?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's right.

SENATOR BOURNE: And the notice says something along the lines of what is...what has been distributed on the floor? Is that what the...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: No, it gives them a toll-free number where they can call to get that information, as I understand it. I just got this bill over the noonhour and the good part about it is that the Nebraska Association of School Boards came in, in
