He read a letter from some lazy school administrators who think handing out a piece of paper is too much work for them. He said three superintendents, or whatever their job was, in his district wrote to him. Not one parent. Senator Foley talks about parents who are opposed to this. He didn't read to us a parent who currently is in school and is...whose children are in school and is angry about this information being given. And as for the letter that he gave us with the names blocked out, we don't even know if that's a real person. We have no way of knowing, and he doesn't know either. Sometimes people write their names in codes, and if you decode it you see that they're laughing at you, they're mocking you, they're ridiculing you. She is supposed to be giving some kind of religious message when she signs off "With His Blessings," and capitalizes all three words. But the key one is the capitalization of "His." With whose blessings? Who is she talking about? I certainly don't know. Senator Foley didn't tell us that. There are mysteries in this letter. The one who wrote this is a mystery. For all I know, a friend of Senator Foley could have written it, or his next-door neighbor, and for all I know, Senator Foley could have written it, for all I actually know. And for all he knows, he could have written it when he was asleep and not aware of what he was doing. How can he deny it? Because he doesn't know what he does when he's asleep. Are you aware that people who snore don't know that they snore? Are you aware of that? Do you know what Senator Erdman told me? He flies airplanes. They give people a card and tell you, if you cannot read this card, ask an attendant for help. Give that to somebody who can't read, and they're going to know what to do with it? People are so conditioned to be dullards that they do not even see inconsistencies, they don't see ironies, they don't see contradictions. They just go along. But I won't. I have to fight this kind of thing that's being done. Women, simply because they comprise a majority, are not going to stand up and do as they ought to do.
