January 13, 2004 LB 810, 811

Chairman of Exec Board, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, LB 810. This bill would repeal a section relating to the Ethanol Pricing Task Force. There was a termination date of December 31, 2000, for this task force, and as this date is passed, this section is no longer needed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Engel, did you wish to close? He waives closing. The question before the body is passage of LB 810. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 810.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 810 advances. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 811, by Senator Engel, as Chair of the Executive Board. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7, referred directly to General File.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Engel, to open on LB 811.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Speaker, members, this bill would repeal three sections relating to revenue and taxation that are obsolete. One section provided for a notice to be given in 1991. The other two sections provided operative dates for legislation in 1993 and 1996. These sections are now no longer needed. I urge the passage.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Open for discussion, advancement of LB 811. Seeing no lights on, Senator Engel, did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity. The question before the body is advancement of LB 811. All in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 811, E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to?
