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FLOOR DEBATE

January 13, 2004 LB 172, 813

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Engel. Members of the Legislature, some things may seem very inconsequential, but I want to know the answer to some questions that are in my mind, and I like to know the reason for things that we do. When Revisor's bills come...are introduced, they do not have a hearing or go to a committee; they're referred directly to General File.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So the only time we have an opportunity to discuss those bills or ask questions is when we come to General File. So I wanted to take that opportunity. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any further discussion on the advancement of LB 813? Seeing nobody wishing to address it, Senator Engel, did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity. The question before the body is advancement of LB 813 to E & R Initial. All in favor of the motion vote aye, those opposed nay. We're voting on advancement of LB 813 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 813.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 813 does advance. We now go to General File, regular General File. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill for consideration, LB 172, discussed yesterday by the Legislature. It's a bill introduced by Senator Foley. (Read title.) The bill was discussed yesterday. When the Legislature adjourned, Senator Schimek had pending AM2066, I believe. Mr. President, that amendment is pending. I do, however, have a priority motion. Senator Chambers would move to bracket LB 172 until April 14, 2004.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your motion.
