SENATOR FOLEY: Oh, you name it. You name it. The media,...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I would like to have them get information from reliable sources, not just their peers, who are sometimes misinformed, not from the Cayhart (sic) clinic, not from a yellow page, not from any of those things. I'd like to have them know that the information they're getting is reliable.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And that is a deep concern.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Schimek, Senator Foley. Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. Yesterday we had a great deal of discussion, and one of the things that I offered was the fact that information can be disseminated in a number of venues. And I questioned whether in fact a piece of paper at the beginning of the school year was the best venue for the information. Senator Schimek has said repeatedly, if you can tell me a better way to do it, fine. So I thought that I would show her what I think might be a better way, because in fact it is the twenty-first century way. It's called the Internet. It took two words: "abortion" and "Nebraska." You'll see it circled at the top of one of the handouts. It's an AOL search. And you'll see that you only have to go down a few places, where I've circled one. It was the first one I happened to click on, because I thought that it showed the most promise. And in fact, I was rewarded, because the site that came up is the second handout I gave you, which is the home page. On there, it tells you just about everything you want to know about a clinic that is available in Nebraska. It even gives you a picture on the back of the first page, so that if you drive up you don't miss it. It gives you, on the second page, a number of links that you can click on. And one of them I have marked with an arrow, which, I used a marker, it's not very clear. It says, Nebraska parental notification law. When you click on that, you get the third handout. So within a matter of 10 to 15 seconds, you have arrived at the parental
