constitution. Senator Schrock knows that no Nebraska Legislature is going to ban fishing. Anybody who thinks that is totally out of his or her mind. But because this is such a silly proposal, so totally lacking in rationality, that I decided to get into the spirit of the proceedings and reduce myself to the level of my colleagues. It's one thing to operate from a position of intelligence, rationality, and respect for the constitution when by so doing people cannot understand what you're talking about, and another thing to get down into the sandbox where those of lesser abilities, lesser understanding, lesser respect from the constitution...for the constitution are found. I'm going to say things to provoke you into voting cloture, to show just how collectively stupid this Legislature is. And you ought to adopt one or some or all of my amendments. So let me get to them, having stated my view of the constitution. And I'm going to continue to elaborate on that notion as we proceed with this lengthy discussion. Here is what my first amendment would do. But before I offer it, let me read the entire text, so that those who watch us on television and the Internet will know what we're dealing with. Senator Price got an e-mail from somebody in California who were watching...who was watching what we're doing here. So to all the intelligent people out there who are watching, I wish some of you were here and could vote. But unfortunately, intelligence is not one of the requirements to be a member of the Legislature. The entire text of LR 4CA follows. "A constitutional amendment to preserve the right to fish, trap, and hunt subject to reasonable restrictions as prescribed by law." I'd like to ask Senator Schrock a question or two, since he is the ringleader.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, would you yield to a question from Senator Chambers, please?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Let me drop "ringleader" and change it to "guru." Senator Schrock, who or what body would be in a position to outlaw fishing in Nebraska?

SENATOR SCHROCK: The Nebraska Legislature could.
