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we don't have anything like this after that? So, Senator Schrock, I'd like to have your response.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you yield, Senator Schrock?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Hartnett, I don't anticipate any legislation to enact this. I think it's very straightforward and very precise.

SENATOR HARTNETT: So you'd give...you'd give...

SENATOR SCHROCK: It says what we want to say. I don't think it's...we in this body do have a lot to say about how Game and Parks regulates hunting and fishing. We have to vote on fee increases. We pretty much give them the right to determine when the season should be open, what the bag limit should be. And, you know, you know, there's been a lot of discussion in the past about prairie dogs. I was a member of the Legislature when LaVon Crosby carried a bill saying that we don't have to exterminate prairie dogs. You were here when she had the bill that says we have...the statute said we have to exterminate prairie dogs; there was no option. Well, we've progressed since that. I don't think this has anything to do with that, but the Legislature, in the past, has had a lot to say about hunting and fishing activities, but we delegate most of that responsibility to the Game and Parks Commission and, as far as I'm concerned, they've done an excellent job of implementing the wishes of the Legislature. We set out the parameters and they fill in the blanks, fill in the details. But I don't have any...this constitutional amendment doesn't require a bill next year if it passes. I don't think...I don't foresee that.

SENATOR HARTNETT: And I think, Senator Schrock, I'm kind of on a different side. I have power with...I have some problems with giving that power to that, and I really would not have any problems with you, just put this in a statute rather than the constitution. I have some concern, because as I read the 11 points here, you know, that brings this much money. I have airplanes in my district. They'd probably bring more money than the activity here, so should I have some constitution dealing with big airplanes? And with the rest of the time, I'll give it
