SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you. Senator Mines, you must have had something given to you by the supernatural powers because, were I not given this opportunity to speak and had you not uttered the wise words you did, I would have gone up in a puff of green acrid smoke and you would never see or hear of me again. (Laugh) Senator Mines pointed out, as others have, that we should not misuse the constitution. I have tried to make it clear how much dislike I have for these activities. I have not brought a bill to get rid of them. Senator Schrock didn't hatch this. Some of those people out there that he is afraid of, that Dwite Pedersen is afraid of, that Senator Kruse is afraid of, made him bring this thing to us. But I am not going to be moved by fear other than the fear of polluting and tainting the constitution. I don't think it has soaked through some of my colleagues' skulls, or penetrated, what it is we're talking about. If something like this were offered as a statute I would have some fun with it, but I would not dig my heels in and go to the mat on something like this, because it states a truism. It does not take away the Legislature's power to regulate these things, so put it in the statutes, Senator Schrock. The only reason he's bringing it at all is because of those groups out there. I don't know why Game and Parks, in their great wisdom and knowledge and understanding of legislation, said that a copy of their resolution should be sent to each state senator and each senator and member of Congress for state of Nebraska. There are no congressmen or senators for the state of Nebraska. They do not work for the state of Nebraska. They are from the state of Nebraska and they are federal officials and they are parts of the national government and they have nothing to do with cockamamie silliness such as putting this craziness into the constitution. That shows you how much intelligence and wisdom these people on the Game and Parks Commission have. They are not put on there because they have intelligence.
