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but I would agree with that, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So if I offer a law...a bill this session, would you cosign it with me?

SENATOR FRIEND: What would be the specifics of the bill?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It would say that should any extraterrestrial enter Nebraska by any means and commit acts of violence or harm against any Nebraska citizen or the property of any Nebraska citizen, the sheriff, the State Patrol, the local law enforcement shall be authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to respond.

SENATOR FRIEND: You're moving in a direction that's changing the analogy again, because you're...I told you that I wanted specifics that would dictate whether something like that would be feasible.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if they would kill a Nebraskan, then there would be authority...

SENATOR FRIEND: But there is no proof that an extraterrestrial would kill a Nebraskan, and we have proof that influenza would, and we also have proof that in certain other states that hunting and fishing has been encroached upon.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Not in any state...

SENATOR FRIEND: So I'm losing your...again, I'm losing your analogy.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then let's bring it right here to Nebraska. Has hunting been encroached upon in Nebraska?

SENATOR FRIEND: Not yet...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Has fishing...

SENATOR FRIEND: ...as far as I know.
