SENATOR CHAMBERS: Has fishing been encroached upon?

SENATOR FRIEND: Not yet, as far as I know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Has trapping been encroached upon?

SENATOR FRIEND: I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, that's what you said about the others, as far as you know. So as far as you know, it hasn't been encroached upon either.

SENATOR FRIEND: No, what I'm saying is, there's a difference between "I don't know" and "no, as far as know."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And as far as you know. But if,...

SENATOR FRIEND: There's a big difference.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...in order to understand, your knowledge has to go one inch, and what I'm asking you requires you to go two inches, then as far as you know, that one inch, it hasn't, as far as you know.

SENATOR FRIEND: I understand. Right. Right. Exactly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's the same as saying you don't know.

SENATOR FRIEND: I don't believe it is. I think there's a little difference.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. I won't quibble. Here's what I want to get to. I believe, from our discussion, it's clear, whether you want to admit it or not, that you are well aware there is no likelihood that hunting, fishing, and trapping are going to be outlawed by the Nebraska Legislature. And by that, I don't mean just the ones of us sitting here now who constitute this session of the Legislature, but at any time in the future. No Nebraska Legislature is going to do that. You don't buy that? What genetic...?
