SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...life forms outside of the solar system of which America...I meant the earth is a part.

SENATOR ERDMAN: So that's a yes?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There's a possibility, but I don't say that I believe. I don't believe in anything other than algebra.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Is this...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's the only thing I believe in.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Okay. So let your yes be yes and your no be no, so I'm going to assume that's a yes. So on the way to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With reference to what? Believing in algebra?

SENATOR ERDMAN: No, in general, that you believe that there's a possibility there's extraterrestrials. And the reason I ask is because you've gone through this whole line of questioning with Senator Friend, but you left out whether or not an extraterrestrial would abduct a Nebraskan, whether or not that should be part of this law.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Abduct. In other words, take out of the state of Nebraska, God forbid,...
