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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR FRIEND: That...thank you, I stand down on that one. Let me ask you this. You've already established the idea that you hate hunting and fishing, correct? Is that...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, no, I hate fishing. I loathe hunting. I detest trapping.

SENATOR FRIEND: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Each one has a category.

SENATOR FRIEND: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR FRIEND: You loathe hunting. Senator Schrock clearly doesn't loathe hunting. There are other folks out on the floor that don't loathe it.

SENATOR FRIEND: No, I have not. But let me...

SENATOR FRIEND: ...ask you this question. Does Senator Schrock, do you believe, based on the test of...or some of the things that we put on the record here, do you believe Senator Schrock hunts animals, wild animals, game type of animals? Do you believe he hunts them?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I believe, based on what Senator Schrock said, he'd be more likely to hunt animals that are not a threat of any kind.
