SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Friend, your time is up. And Senator Chambers,...

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Chambers, there's no other speaker. Would you like to close on your amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I would. And I think I'm closing in on a point.
