SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...Senator Friend, let me take...

SENATOR FRIEND: ...I know. I'm just kidding.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, okay.

SENATOR FRIEND: On the record, I'm just kidding. Look, what I'm...the point that I'm trying to make, and the question that I have for you...it's a point and then a question. Senator Schrock, I think a reasonable person on this floor and a reasonable person in this state, a reasonable person sitting in the Natural Resources Committee that heard this testimony would believe that Senator Schrock and maybe a couple of other folks that sit on that committee are, if not experts, pretty darn close to that, as far as hunting and fishing. They've been doing it their whole life. You, Senator Chambers, have been analyzing and critiquing the constitution and laws of this state virtually your whole adult life. I am putting you at the same level, not...expert is a...I think we're arguing semantics. I'm putting you at the same level, because I think there are a lot of folks in this state, in the city of Omaha, in this Chamber, that respect your ability as far as constitutional concerns are related.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But here...but here's...

SENATOR FRIEND: I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...here's the difference,...

SENATOR FRIEND: And my question is, why can't we give Senator Schrock and other folks on this floor the same respect? You are disrespecting them with an amendment that brings them back to square one. I don't think that they're doing it to be mean and to spite you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I didn't say they...

SENATOR FRIEND: That's my point.
