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Hanna-Barbera's Gazoo. They came to Earth in a peaceful attitude, they did not seek to do us any harm, and they only wanted us to take them to our leaders, and they're not a significant food source. Again, I do support LR 4CA, and I look forward to perhaps getting some more collaboration, and perhaps revisiting it. I do believe it's important, and I do represent the people in my district, and indeed a vast majority of the people in the state. And let it go to a vote. The constitution does belong to the people, and they have...also have a say in what goes in the constitution. They have voiced their opinion that they would like to see it there, and at least give them a chance to vote on it. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Combs. Senator Chambers, followed by Senator Smith, and Wehrbein.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, what I see from this discussion is an unwholesome paranoia on the part of rural people. I don't know whether it's because of their isolation, the depressed economy, or a defect in education, but Senator Wehrbein made those comments...I mean, not Senator Wehrbein, Senator Schrock, such as "forces out there." That's what I was hearing when everything was a communist plot. And they pronounced it "cumminis'" in those days, c-u-m-m-i-n-i-s-'. They didn't even put the "t" on it. It's a "cumminis'" plot, everything. And these are the same people who want to be carrying concealed guns. They're afraid of shadows. And they want to taint the constitution. Instead of kowtowing to paranoia, these senators should be trying to allay, alleviate it, and explain to people that they have nothing to fear but fear itself. Ignorance is the greatest enemy of any society, and ignorance is driving this attempt to put hunting, fishing, and trapping in the constitution. Senator Schrock's arguments show why it should not be done. He says he is confident that if this was put to a vote of the people it would pass in all 49 districts. If that's the case, what are they afraid of? Do they look under their bed every night before they get in it, because the monsters are under there and going to climb up and snatch every farmer? You all shouldn't be terrorizing your children like that. But I'm not worried, because children often are smarter than their parents, and
