SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Mr. Clerk, priority motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Objection, Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, did you wish to move to bracket?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, Mr. President, I would move to bracket this until February 3, 2004.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're recognized to open on your bracket motion, Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Chambers, I'm...I feel bad that you are not going to be a part of this. The group that is supporting this, I would like to have a chance to talk with them, to find out what direction they want to go. We would like to maybe consider the statutory way. We would like to maybe consider whether they would want to try and do the petition process. We need a little time to talk it over. As I have told you, this is not something I've done in a vacuum. I've done it because I've been asked to do it by a group of people whose opinions I value a lot. And so from that standpoint, I'm a little puzzled as to why you wouldn't cooperate in letting us do...in letting us bracket this until February 3. If I can be of any assistance in keeping you informed as to what our intentions are between now and then, I would do that. I will do everything I can to be fair with you on this issue. But it would be my intent and wishes to have this bracketed until February 3.
