It was out of committee once. It was killed last year. I'm coming back with a new version this year. I think it was advanced two years ago; we just didn't get to it. Does that get to what you're asking about?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, it sure does. Thank you, Senator Thompson.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you.

SENATOR BYARS: And I want to tie it in directly to Senator Aguilar's bill, because I think as we're talking about young people, God bless them, they're wonderful, but they do distract more easily sometimes. They're much like senators, in that they get distracted easily. And I think he is saying we need to have safety provisions in place.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BYARS: I would go further, and I feel that every occupant in a vehicle needs to be restrained, regardless of age. And we'll face that issue later. But I want to strongly support what Senator Aguilar is doing. And I certainly am mindful of what Senator Beutler is wanting to do, and I also would ask we move this bill to Select File, and let's sit down and talk, if we need to, about some details.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. Senator Quandahl, on LB 227.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I thought that I'd get up and just try to flesh out on a topic on this bill that actually Senator Smith and Senator Wehrbein touched upon a little bit earlier.
