SENATOR VRTISKA: ...around the district,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...there just is not that type of procedure. And I'm just concerned about how they're going to make these legal and how they're going to fit in under the law that you're talking about. I'm not opposing the idea that people ought to be restrained. I don't think that's the issue. My issue is how we're going to determine where they're in violation of any law or not. Yes, respond.

SENATOR AGUILAR: And I think I can assure you, in a town that size and that familiar with each other, I don't think anybody is going to hassle anybody whether they've got a permit or not. And if there's a parade and it's allowed, they're exempted. You know, it's not going to be a problem there.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Baker, followed by Senators Vrtiska, Chambers, Hartnett, and Redfield. Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. I'm going to make a profound statement here, beginning. This bill was heard a year ago. I'm looking back over the committee statement, so...and we're kind of fuzzy in our memory of how we got where we are, I think, including the bill's sponsor, shaking his head yes. I did want to clarify one thing, that before we advanced it out of committee, it was understood that as a condition of employment a person could ride in the back of a pickup, meaning detassellers and, I think in the case of Senator Wehrbein's people going between hay fields, that would meet a condition of employment. I think back in my own business, something we'd do, moving between pastures, fixing fence and things like that, I think that would be a condition of employment. So I wanted to make that clear in the record. That's one of the reasons we advanced the bill out. We felt it took care of the agricultural issues, whether it was detassellers or working in hay fields, so on, fixing fence. And Senator
