SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, I'm going to acknowledge something this morning that some people may think is the case with me all the time. I am experiencing some confusion. Before I continue my other discussion with Senator Baker--and I know my time is running--I've got to coordinate a couple of items in the committee amendment with material in the original copy of the bill. I would like to ask now Senator Baker a question about an item in the committee amendment. Because we can get back to the discussion of the batches later. Senator Baker. SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. If you look in line 2, which section do you see listed there?

SENATOR BAKER: 60-6,324...or 34, Section 34.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now would you turn to page 19 of the committee amendment?

SENATOR BAKER: I think what you're referring to is not the committee amendment; it's AM2177? Is that...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yeah, AM2177.

SENATOR BAKER: And which page were you saying, 16?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Nineteen.

SENATOR BAKER: Nineteen.
