Kruse, Senator Cunningham. Senator Baker, did you authorize call-ins?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I would authorize call-ins.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Call-ins have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Bromm voting yes. Senator Preister voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Maxwell voting yes. Senator Smith voting yes. Senator Price voting yes. Senator Kruse voting yes. Senator Mines voting yes. Senator Cunningham...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Baker's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted. I do raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend with FA1418. (Legislative Journal page 294.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, to open on amendment FA1418.

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. For those of you who recall an hour and a half or so ago, Senator Chambers and I struck a deal where we changed...amended an amendment, and then I agreed to file an amendment going back to the stricken matter, reinstating the stricken matter, which would leave the fee at \$1 per copy of the vehicle registration. That's all this does, is restates (sic) the stricken matter and on line 4 of page 39 of the green copy, reinstates...actually, it's on line 3 and 4, and strikes the new language; retains the \$1 charge for an individual title certificate or search. I'd urge its adoption. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the opening on FA1418, offered by Senator Baker to LB 560. Now open for discussion on that amendment. Senator Chambers.
