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and halved the others that were proposed in the green copy. The second part of the committee amendments delete the new language on page 6, on lines 4 through 11. And you can follow along if you wish. It simply says that if a citation is issued, subject to Section...or Chapter 60, Section 348, that the judge shall impose a \$50 fine at a minimum. That's if a citation is issued. In addition to that \$50 minimum fine, the prosecuting attorney may bring an action to recover civil penalty of \$500. That's an option the prosecuting attorney would have. All penalties shall be remitted to the State Treasurer. And that's just simply to the schools. So that is what we've done with the committee amendment. And I would be glad to answer any questions. Certainly encourage you to adopt the committee amendments. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the opening on the committee amendments offered by the Transportation Committee. Mr. Clerk, amendments to them.

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, thank you. Senator Smith, you had AM2197, drafted as an amendment to the committee amendments. But I have a note you wish to withdraw AM2197.

SENATOR SMITH: That is correct.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith would move to amend with AM2222 as an amendment to the committee amendments. (Legislative Journal page 274.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, did you wish to take that up?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may do so.

SENATOR SMITH: Senator Cudaback and members, as I had mentioned earlier, this gets rid of some of the confusing parts with the auto registration renewals. If you're concerned about folks driving with an old Nebraska license plate, this bill may not be for you, or the amendment may not be for you. But I wanted to simplify it and take one step at a time, and hopefully address
