SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So we would have only the green copy and your amendment before us. Is that correct? If this amendment that you have now is adopted, what...?

SENATOR SMITH: Right. I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...what amendments would it strike?

SENATOR SMITH: Just the committee amendment. We would be back to the green copy, but also, basically replacing the green copy with my amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you read how your amendment goes? I'm trying to get back to the first part, because I had gone a few pages ahead. Okay. Strike the original sections...oh, strike the original amendments, and insert the following new amendment. And that then would be to strike the original sections, which would make your amendment that you're offering now the bill.

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is it better or worse than the green copy without any amendment?

SENATOR SMITH: It's better than the green copy...what do you mean, without any amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Just as it stands, the green copy. Is it better or worse than the green copy unamended?

SENATOR SMITH: It's better than the green copy. The green copy, to me, is a bit draconian.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is it better than the green copy with the committee amendment?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.
