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amendment? Because now I know where we are.

SENATOR SMITH: Sure. The committee amendment addresses the lack of auto registration renewal, or a late renewal. And as I said, I don't want to belabor that point today. I think that's an argument for another time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does your amendment strike the ten-day grace period?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: For people who live in Nebraska also, correct?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And would there be this minimum \$50 fine that the judge would impose?

SENATOR SMITH: Not...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does your amendment do that, which is something the committee amendment does?

SENATOR SMITH: My amendment does not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That would be on page 5, or 6. That would be on page 6, I think. Now, the language on page 5, in the green copy, talks about this schedule of fees for late registration. Does that schedule remain intact in your amendment?

SENATOR SMITH: No, it does not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What does your amendment do that's different?

SENATOR SMITH: Than the green copy, or the committee amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, let's say the committee amendment, because...
