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SENATOR JONES: You know the little tag that you get every year? That's built into this price for the plates. So you don't have to pay for that little tag each year anyway. So what you have to do is pay for the taxes on it, you know. That's what you're paying each year.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I know.

SENATOR JONES: So, anyway.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But I just still wonder if it's cost-effective for the state to do this.

SENATOR JONES: I haven't heard no comment about that. The county officials are all in favor of this.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Who did?

SENATOR JONES: The county officials are in favor of this.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, what's DMV say?

SENATOR JONES: They're in favor of this, too.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But have they done a cost analysis?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I think they have. In fact,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I admit, I don't have my file up here. I didn't look at the fiscal. But historically, that was...all through the early nineties, we did not do this. And so I'm just wondering if something has changed.

SENATOR JONES: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, I won't pursue it, but I...well, I will. I'm going to keep listening. Thank you.

SENATOR JONES: Okay.
