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sense to move a bill on, and then the parties that are interested in it will get together, so I'm not saying I will oppose that in every instance. But it's becoming routine now--just run it over there and we'll do something with it. Senators have staff in their office. They send trash bills to the senator. The senator sends it to the committee. It's recycled out here as trash; then I've got to be the garbageman, and I'm getting tired of it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Baker mentioned about the cost of shipping, and I just want to answer that simple question. If we choose to now...at least in Douglas County, I don't know what you do in the other counties...have our plates handled by mail, we have to pay for that anyway. We have a choice whether or not we want to go to the office and pick up the plates, or we want to pay, I think it's a \$6 fee. I may be wrong on that. It could be half that, but I think it's a \$6 fee that we pay for the privilege of mailing. And so there...I do believe that that part should be paid for as part of the cost. But I don't know who's paying for the shipping now, if it's Department of Corrections, for instance, and any kind of business didn't have to truck the plates out now, instead of...could mail them out on an individual basis, I think that price would come down a lot, too, because you wouldn't have the price of trucking. You could use that for the postage. But I think it has to be looked in...a good, close look, because it could save a whole lot across the board and it could save all that handling. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Senator Baker, committee amendments.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. Back to the bill we had yesterday, I have to answer some of the criticism heaped upon us by Senator Chambers, that was not a committee amendment that brought that bill down. It was Senator Smith's amendment. But...and I think we're doing good work over
