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don't, I'm just going to take out after this stuff this session, and I think that's what ought to be done. If I had serious problems with Senator Jones' bill, I would raise those issues now and I would want to correct them on General File. This bill that Senator Jones has presented to us is not a complex, hard-to-understand piece of legislation. Anything that needs to be addressed could be addressed with an amendment, and we could do the work on General File. If, on the other hand, somebody needs additional information before being able to make up his or her mind, then, and they have no objection to the bill, let it go and get that additional information. But if there are problems that they see in the bill now, this is where we ought to do the heavy lifting. But because we don't, we have more to debate on some bills on Select File than we have on General File because we put it off to another day. If we did the proper work on General File, I will wager, but I can't guarantee, that some senators would get with their staff, or whoever they have to get with, and say let's clean up this bill so that when it comes up for debate we can offer amendments to correct it, to smooth it out and get it closer to the form it ought to be in. But since all they have to do is say, oh, that got by me; I wasn't aware that's what it did, but let's run it on over to Select File and we'll clean it up...but if the body agrees to do that, I'm not going to say don't blame me. I'm going to tell you blame me, b-l-a-m-e moi, m-o-i, because I am going...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to take out after these bills, and I may do it with a greater vengeance since we didn't want to do the work on General File. But as of now, so that I won't have given Senator Jones heartburn, I'm not opposed to his bill and I'm not saying this in opposition to his bill, but the opposition I expressed was to some of the notions people were talking about in terms of increasing the cost of registration. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Baker, there are no further senators wishing to speak on the measures. You may close on AM0451, offered by the Transportation Committee, if you care to.
