money, but it's clear money is not going to be saved. So what will they do? They'll come in here crying for more money. I had stated that at this point I was not opposed to Senator Jones' bill. That opposition may develop...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...as I think more deeply about this issue. If I support the bill in its present form, I'm not simply giving some maybe misdirected but well-intentioned officials what they want. I may be supporting something that could ultimately boomerang and hurt the public in terms of increased costs for something else. So I'm going to continue to listen and think and determine what it is that I ought to do. And this is the first time I've spoken on this amendment, so I'm going to turn my light on again. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Stuthman, on the Baker amendment.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I did discuss this issue with Senator Baker. He had stated that there would be a \$3.50 cost per plate that would add up to be \$7 for the plate, in the...and a savings of \$3.30. As compared to going to, what we're doing right now, \$5 for three years, would be \$10 for the total in the six-year. That, those numbers, didn't equate right when he made the statement, but he has communicated with me and it's \$3.35 per plate, which would be \$6.70. Then the savings would be \$3.30. So this was the question that I had and this is the reason that I put my light on. I wanted to clarify that, hopefully, to get that. So there would be, in the total six years, to the individuals receiving new plates, if you went with a six-year plate, your savings over that next six years would be, in comparison to the three-year sequence that we're on right now, would be \$3.30 for the individuals receiving the plates. This would be the savings to the people. Everything else, in my estimation, would be the same. So I just wanted to clarify that a little bit, and it is a savings to the people registering their vehicles. Thank you, and I return the rest of my time to the Chair.
