SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. Senator Hartnett, on the Baker amendment to LB 279.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator Baker, could I ask you some questions, please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you yield for a question?

SENATOR HARTNETT: When will I get my new...under this proposal, when would I get my new license plates?

SENATOR BAKER: Cycle begins 2004, this year.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Two thousand...okay, I'll get new license plates 2004. And then, then...

SENATOR BAKER: Well, no.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...in two...then, in 2000...

SENATOR BAKER: We're at the end of the cycle now. They're making the plates, but you won't get them until 2005.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. I get my new plates in 2...

SENATOR BAKER: I think your county is one of them they're making, actually, but they're not out there yet.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. I get my new plates in 2005. The next year, 2006, I have to put a sticker on my plates, correct?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I have to pay a fee for that. What's the fee for that?

SENATOR BAKER: Just a renewal fee and I...I'm going to have to check on that. I don't know what it is. I don't think there's a fee. You go in and pay your registration fee and so on. That's standard. It's \$15 (inaudible).
