SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...I'm trying to show you the preposterous measures that people go through to figure how to plunder the treasury of this state to help these speculators. Those are the ones who are making the money. I'd like to ask Senator Baker a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you respond?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, did I hear you say you support this amendment?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I do, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, would you agree to convert the name of this fund from the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund to the Guaranteed Profit for Ethanol Speculators?

SENATOR BAKER: No, I would not because if I...and I'd give you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, I'll accept that.

SENATOR BAKER: No. No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Since Senator Baker has said he will support this amendment and gave his reasons for it, I'm not going to carry the discussion further, but I will listen to what others say if they raise questions. So far, nobody has questioned the removal of this language.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Cunningham, on the Chambers amendment.
