SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you respond.

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I would.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, did you say you support this amendment?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And in order that people can be aware that you and I have had conversations, did you prevail upon me to agree to withdraw at this stage of debate my second amendment which is up there which would say that \$1,500,000, which had been taken out of this incentive fund during a special session, there is language which says that by 2008, I believe, that money will be put back into that fund. My amendment, my second one, would strike that language. You and I discussed it, and you prevailed on me to withdraw that amendment related to that \$1.5 million if this one is adopted, is that true?

SENATOR BAKER: That's true. I don't know whether the words "prevail upon you" but I think we agreed to it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, you bludgeoned me into submission. Does that meet more with your approval?

SENATOR BAKER: Something like that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, thank you. Mr. President, I have nothing further to say and I will start by asking for a call of the house, and then I'll take a machine vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There has been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, those opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.
