SENATOR CHAMBERS: We can proceed with the vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers said we may proceed with the vote. The question before the body is adoption of AM2253 to committee amendment, AM0852, to LB 479. All in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment, AM2253, to the committee amendments offered by the Revenue Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendments have been adopted. Mr. Clerk. I do raise the call, please. Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend the committee amendments, AM2254.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I will drag my battered, bleeding body to this microphone and ask that I be allowed to withdraw this amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the committee amendments themselves, AM0852, offered by the Revenue Committee
