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SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Erdman, on the committee amendments, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I was going to rise and address a similar point that Senator Beutler did but wanted to note that I have similar concerns as far as that language and I think that there are others that have contracts besides the one that Senator Beutler mentioned that may be affected by this. And this state may stand some liability should we not proceed with caution with the justified rationale. So I'll be looking for the Attorney General's Opinion as well. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Beutler a question in order that I might have clarification.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, would you respond to a question from Senator Chambers?
