SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you agree with it?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you have a copy of it before you?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you look in line 10? Have you found line 10?

SENATOR SMITH: On page 1?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I see the two words "human embryo." Do you see those two words?

SENATOR SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why don't you require that they put "unborn child"?

SENATOR SMITH: I believe that human embryos would include that, and I don't want to put in more words there than what's absolutely necessary.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: To you, the embryos mentioned in the committee amendment are unborn children. Is that your understanding? Or are these embryos something different from unborn children?

SENATOR SMITH: I'm not sure what you're trying to get at, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm asking you a question.

SENATOR SMITH: I understand that.
