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society who have devalued it to recognize that the killing on the street and the abuse in the home...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR KRUSE: ...and the other things that are going on are against the principles that we hold together and support. I call for this body not to set limits on research into how our cells operate. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kruse. Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I am not one of them who is going to dispute what our good senator over...my good friend has said, as far as...and I'm not...we're not getting in a shouting match, rather. I'll just, maybe, perhaps dispute something he said, but not get into a shouting match because I think this is something that really needs to be discussed. I agree with Senator Smith. I think as we discuss the research that the university was doing a few years ago that...and they did battle that. They did not battle this particular bill, because they took in a...they testified in neutral capacity, so evidently they feel that it's not going to affect their research. I do believe that when this is the...the stem cells and et cetera is the easy way. I think there's other ways to develop these...this research. You're talking about adult stem cells. I agree that we are old. (Laugh) In fact, Senator Kruse and I can attest to that. We are old. But we're very...well, I'll let you tell how...about us otherwise. But anyhow...but the umbilical cord, now, that's...that isn't old. That's new. And they're talking about research from the umbilical cords where they can do this. But are they really pursuing these avenues to...where they would...if this bill is passed, I think they would expedite their research and expediting further avenues. From what I've...and I'm not, certainly not a doctor. I've been treated by them different times, but I'm not a doctor. I don't pretend to have medical knowledge. But from the information I'm getting from them, it says, one of the things I have here, the only difference between reproductive cloning and therapeutic cloning is whether the cloned embryo is implanted or destroyed for stem cells.
