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SENATOR MAXWELL: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you had a chance to review it?

SENATOR MAXWELL: I have read it. What I said, Senator, is I'm not going to pretend that I understand all the implications, but I've read it, yes.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Uh-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...what you'll be voting for is this amendment.

SENATOR MAXWELL: Correct. Well,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So if...

SENATOR MAXWELL: ...assuming we adopt the amendment, yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. Well, no. When the cloture vote comes, that's right, you'll be voting for this amendment. There will be no...
