SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Brashear, would you yield?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Madam Chair.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Brashear, and I won't pin you down as to your support of the bill. But if you recall, what you had said earlier is that there was no committee amendment...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That's correct.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...because the lobbyist indicated that he just wanted a vote to get it out of committee.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That was the...that was the first time it came out.

SENATOR BOURNE: Not this...not this time that we're looking at now?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Not this time. That was the prior session.

SENATOR BOURNE: But this bill came out of the Judiciary Committee last session,...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: 6-2.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...okay, because the lobbyist said, hey, just give me a vote to get it out; it's not going anywhere. Is that your recollection or...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That is my recollection...

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.
