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SENATOR BOURNE: I...let me tell you where I'm at.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Okay.

SENATOR BOURNE: I support the concept.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Uh-huh.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay? Absolutely support the concept, but I don't believe that this, the green copy or the amendment, is properly drafted. I think there are numerous flaws in the legislation, ambiguities, vagueness, definitional problems, and so I support the concept, absolutely, but I don't support either the green copy or the amendment. I am looking for ways to get to substantive changes. I don't know how you do that...

SENATOR MOSSEY: Okay.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...given where we're at.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Okay. Thank you. Once again, I would just reiterate I do not support the recommit to committee, and I'd yield the rest of my time to Senator Synowiecki, if he would like to respond to anything.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Synowiecki, there is 1 minute and 21 seconds left.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Thank you, Senator Mossey. And indeed, I appreciate the input provided by Senator Bourne, other members of the Legislature that believe in this concept. It's my hope that we can eventually arrive at a bill here that would embody the concept...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: ...embody the concept behind the bill, to get it logistically correct. And I, too, am looking at avenues that we can arrive at that, and one option would be to advance the bill to Select File and provide, during that interim, input from the Judiciary Committee, Senator Brashear, Senator Bourne,
