SENATOR JOHNSON: No, the sexual offenders are in the present law, the sexual and violent offenders, murderers.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. So I'll just interrupt you quickly again...

SENATOR JOHNSON: (Inaudible) there.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...to ask you. So the fact that on this map you sent around Nebraska is no color there, doesn't mean...

SENATOR JOHNSON: We're basic.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...there's no...there's nothing in place now. We do have something in place, and what you're talking about is expanding what's in place.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, that's correct, and with rather minimal expansion. And basically, the committee said we agree with the expansion to the burglary and robbery people as well, but we don't have the money and we're going to wait for the federal funding.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR JOHNSON: What we're saying...

SENATOR RAIKES: So...what?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Well, I was just going (inaudible).

SENATOR RAIKES: Go ahead and finish. Excuse me.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yeah. I was just going to say what we're saying is the federal money doesn't look like it's going to happen. We don't think that we ought to wait around any longer. The amount of money we're talking about is \$90,000 to start with and about \$30,000 each year thereafter, and we're talking about the budget of the State Patrol being \$40 million.
