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SENATOR STUHR: Okay. Yes, that does help. And is Senator Johnson still here?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: Also on your number 5, you have on page 3 and page 4, and I think you're referring to the standing committee amendments. I don't have a page 4, so that's why I'm a little confused on the standing. These are the standing committee amendments, I believe, AM1057, so...okay.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Okay.

SENATOR STUHR: All right.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Okay. I'm sorry.

SENATOR STUHR: I understand that it is different on our machines than the printout that we have. Is that correct?

SENATOR JOHNSON: I believe so.

SENATOR STUHR: Okay. Thank you. Well, I do support what you are trying to do. I just...I was trying to follow along on the amendment and...

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yeah.

SENATOR STUHR: ...those were the questions. Thank you.

SENATOR JOHNSON: And that's why I went to just kind of the statement at the end here, is that because of we are making an amendment to the committee amendment, basically we come down to the fact that, rather than waiting for the federal funding and so on, we're going to strike that.

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Let's proceed.
