SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Johnson,...

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, sir.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...I have some concern about the fiscal note, which is no surprise. The original bill, I noticed, has no fiscal note. And I think you explained that you were using federal funds. There's an updated...

SENATOR JOHNSON: We were attempting to.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And there's an updated fiscal note dated December 13 that shows no fiscal impact, at least for the university and the State Patrol, which I assume meant that they didn't have additional expenses, assuming federal funds. Now, this amendment apparently does change that. And you mentioned the number \$90,000?

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yes, sir. No, we're definitely saying that the State Patrol, in their present budget, would be responsible for the inclusion of doing this.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Are you assured that they can absorb that? I know you mentioned the term 40; it's actually \$48 million. But I...

SENATOR JOHNSON: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...have been told that there's going to be a fiscal note submitted for second round, so you understand.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Okay. Well, and I understand that we have made them aware of our intentions and have received nothing contrary to that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR JOHNSON: So that's the best that I can tell you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, I don't know. Have you had a conversation on whether they could absorb this? Is that what
