SENATOR JOHNSON: I guess I'm...our office has contacted them, told them what our figures are, and so on, and this is the intent of the bill, and the expense, and we have heard nothing to the contrary that they wouldn't bear the expense.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: All right. I'm just being a little bit cautious.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And I wanted clarification on...was it 90 the first year and 30 year...\$30,000 thereafter?

SENATOR JOHNSON: I believe that's about...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Was that what you said?

SENATOR JOHNSON: ...what our numbers come up with. Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yeah. Okay, I'm going to support the bill. Sounds fine to me, but obviously, with a caveat on Select File.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Well, and this is why the bill wasn't brought up last year.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Dwite Pedersen. Is Senator Pedersen...oh, excuse me, I did not see you, Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I stand mostly to encourage Senator Synowiecki to continue his effort to add that on Select File, because I...you know, as I too work in the field, there are people with sexual assaults who do get...who do not end up incarcerated, in the community. And I would think that that would be something easy to add on an amendment on Select File. With that, if...whatever time I have left, I'd be glad to give to Senator Synowiecki if
