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first of all, I do appreciate Senator Schrock's work and effort on this issue. However, I...and I do believe that perhaps the best issue is to leave it up to the cities. The only thing is I have concern if we take this above the limit levels that we have put on those communities. I have had, in the past, in my history, probably I've been on five or six NRD boards, and through...not NRD boards, excuse me, on (laugh) SID boards. Thank you very much. Sanitation and improvement districts. And through that process when you develop land and when you have a SID and you decide on what are to be special assessments and general obligations, those obligations set forth for the entire community or for the city, itself, and by the way, the city of Omaha oversees all of those sanitation and improvement districts that are set up. But always storm sewers are a general obligation of the city, and it would seem to me that that's the way they should remain. They should still be within that budget limit. And if we don't, what's going to be next to come outside and go over that limit? And so I would support the bracket motion and certainly will look forward to where we go from there. But I do believe that storm sewers are a general obligation and they should remain so and they should also be within the lid as far as I'm concerned. With that, I will return the rest of my time back to the Chair. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, there is no point at this point in getting into a further debate about the proper way to go on this, but let me ask you, Senator Schrock, if this is going to be laid over till Thursday, did you say?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That's my intention.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, and when Thursday comes, has the Speaker indicated that this could come back up again?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, the Speaker was a little late in getting here this morning, so I didn't have a chance to talk to him. So the Speaker will do what he wants to do but that would be my
