SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, I would yield my time to the Speaker for comment on the matter. (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, spend as much time as you need. (Laughter)

SENATOR BEUTLER: (Microphone malfunction)...that much time, Senator Cudaback.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, and thank you, Senator Beutler, I think. Would Senator Schrock yield to a question, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, will you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I will.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, I'm still trying to get my computer up here to see what you're doing, but I gather that you're offering to bracket this bill until the day after tomorrow?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: And what is your intent at that point?

SENATOR SCHROCK: We will have an amendment drafted that will put the burden on property taxes and with probably some NRD involvement. And we didn't think we could get that drafted this morning and we didn't think we could get the cities of Omaha and Lincoln together to get their input on this till then. But we need to deal with this in a rather forthright manner, probably fairly quickly. And at that point on Thursday, if you will put it up, I will...you know, we will need some discussion but I will be ready for an up or down vote. If it fails, it fails. If it passes, it passes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay, and Thursday you think is enough time?
