SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I do.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay. Well, having heard that, and in the interest of floor time and the issues we have before us, I'd certainly try to accommodate that. If not Thursday, certainly shortly thereafter. So I'd try to work with Senator Schrock on that, Senator Beutler. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Did you wish to have your time back, Senator Beutler?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I will yield the rest of my time to the Chair. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. There are no further lights on. Asking unanimous consent to bracket the bill till Thursday morning or after. So ordered.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We now move on to General File, 2003 senator priority bills. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 762 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of last year, at that time referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments. I have other amendments pending as well, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Brashear, would you like to give us a review?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. May I open on the bill?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you. Good morning, everyone. I...in my attempt to have this be one of the more collegial debates that we'll have, I'll begin by welcoming you all to Common Cause of Nebraska day in the Legislature. And I'll introduce myself as chief villain, and unintended but ex officio fund-raiser for
