constituents' concerns are that that will be exacerbated by this additional bill. So Senator Baker, you keep saying that you've taken out the requirement for two forms of identification. And I want to just kind of go over that with you quickly, if you would. On line...on page 6, starting in Section (6)(a), line 6, the existing language of the statute said, "Except for an individual under the age of eighteen years, each individual applying for an operator's license or a state identification card shall furnish proof of date of birth and identity by," then it talks about a valid Nebraska operator's license, a valid Nebraska learner permit, a valid Nebraska school permit, then it goes on to list other things. Well, as I went through the committee amendment and then marked up the green copy of the bill, I don't see where that requirement for the two forms of identification has changed. And maybe I just am not awake yet this morning, but I'm trying to see where your committee amendment, or the committee amendment, changes the two pieces of ID requirement. Could you help me?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I could, Senator Bourne. And I briefly mentioned this in my opening on the committee amendment, that there's a follow-up amendment, AM2241, which strikes that new language. That's the next amendment we will address, that strikes the...all the new language you're referring to in Section (6) sub (a).

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So the committee amendment left the two forms of ID. Then, if your amendment, AM2241, is adopted, then it goes back to just one form of ID?

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. Let me ask you this. And again, I have not read that amendment yet; I'm still trying to get through the committee amendment and mark up my green copy. Go down a little further on that page, starting in line 19, and when you add the committee amendment language, it would say, "Any individual who presents a valid Nebraska operator's license or Nebraska state identification card may present that document," and here's the committee amendment, "for consideration for identification for issuance of such license or identification card."
