all over the place. I understand that. They came up in committee, the hearing. We worked through this with committee members, and got to where we are with the committee amendments. I will caution you that the next amendment is actually the one that strikes the two forms of ID. But we need to adopt the committee amendment, and we'll talk briefly then about what AM2241 does again, the following amendment. I urge your adoption of the committee amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing on the committee amendments. The question before the body is, shall those amendments be adopted? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the committee amendments, offered by the Transportation Committee to LB 559. Have you all voted who care to on the committee amendments to LB 559? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker, AM2192. But I have a note you want to withdraw AM2192, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend with AM2241. (Legislative Journal page 317.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, to open on AM2241 to LB 559.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. As we've already discussed this amendment, I'm not going to take a lot of time with it. AM2241 strikes the new language that requires two forms of identification for a driver's license or the ID card. That's stricken from the green copy of the bill
