have Social Security number. It does provide some additional forms of identification for someone under 18. That's in the bill and has not been discussed, but it provides some additional avenues for someone under 18 to obtain a state ID card--not a driver's license; a state ID card. So that, I think, pretty much summarizes the bill as amended. I'd still...I obviously would urge your adoption. And anyone who has any other questions, I'd be glad to work with them. Any time they want to come in, we'd go over any other details or questions they may have. I urge advancement of the bill to Select File. Thank you.
