SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. The next speaker in order is Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler, you're recognized to speak.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schimek, members of the Legislature, Senator Schrock, just a few questions, if I might.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I will yield.

SENATOR BEUTLER: This is a permitting fee, and the types of business organizations and industries that are permitted under this program would be a variety of industries, private industries?

SENATOR SCHROCK: And I did give an example of some of those industries.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Did you catch that earlier?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I did not. Could you just...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay. Well, the large emitters would be facilities like Cargill, OPPD, NPPD, Nucor. The medium-type facilities generally contains all...most of the ethanol plants, with the exception of Cargill, which is larger, like Cornhusker, Husker Ag, KAAPA. Excel Corporation would be part of the...would be an example of a medium one. Small emitters would be...an example would be a veterinary clinic incinerator or a portable asphalt plant that you see...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...when they set up along side construction sites.
