SENATOR SCHROCK: That's very possible.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senators Beutler and Schrock. Any further discussion on the amendment? Seeing no lights, Senator Schrock, would you like to close on your amendment, AM2218?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I will close on that. This just changes the date. But, Senator Chambers, for your information, somebody out behind the glass knew the answer. The human hair is about 60 microns across, across, not length, diameter.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Schrock, was that your closing?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That's my closing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: (Laugh) Okay. Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR SCHROCK: And I'm sticking to it. (Laugh)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. The question is the adoption of AM2218 to LB 449. All in favor signify by voting aye, all opposed nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted. We are back to discussion of the bill. Senator Stuthman, your light is first up.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. I have a couple questions and I would like to direct them to Senator Schrock.
